## Top 10 creams for cracked heels

Tackle the hard skin of your feet in time for summer



**Lorna Mairs, 26,**  
Buxton, Derbyshire

**TESTED: Margaret Dabbs Intensive Treatment Foot Oil, £25 for 200ml**

'A little goes a long way with this foot oil, and I didn't find it too greasy. I loved the fresh citrus smell and my feet felt extremely soft afterwards. It's a lovely treat, but a bit out of my price range.' **7/10**

**TESTED: Flexitol Heel Balm, £4.99 for 56g**

'This non-greasy cream smelt a bit like baby powder. Although it made my feet feel moisturised, it didn't make a lot of difference to the hard skin. I wouldn't bother with it again.' **5/10**

**TESTED: Newtons Cracked Heel Repair Cream, £4.49 for 150ml**

'This has a creamy texture with a minty fragrance. My feet felt softer, but it didn't have a lasting effect. I do have dry, cracked heels, but this cream was no different to others I've tried.' **6/10**

**TESTED: CCS Foot Care Cream, £7.35 for 175ml**

'The cream has a nice texture with a pleasant smell, and it worked really well within a few days of using it twice a day. My feet felt really smooth and soft - I would buy it again.' **9/10**

**TESTED: Lotil cream, £2.99 for 50ml**

'This cream was light and non-greasy but had quite a strong smell. You only need a small amount, so it would last a long time. The skin on my feet was not so cracked and dry after regular use. It's good value so I'd buy it again.' **9/10**

**TESTED: E45 Foot & Heel Cream, £6.99 for 75ml**

'I thought this cream was very good value. It doesn't have a scent, and it has a nice, creamy texture, but I did find it slightly greasy. It did make a difference to my feet - they were much softer after a few days' use.' **8/10**

**TESTED: Boots Gorgeous Foot Cracked Heel Repair, £5.49 for 100ml**

'This thick and creamy foot cream smelt divine - it was a pleasure to use. There was a definite improvement to my feet after a week of use - they were a lot softer and not so dry.' **7/10**

**TESTED: Compeed Dry & Cracked Skin Cream, £4.85 for 75ml**

'This is a thick cream with a light and subtle fragrance. Although it takes a little while for it to be absorbed into the skin, it did make my feet feel smooth and moisturised.' **8/10**

**TESTED: Scholl Cracked Heel Repair Cream, £5.49 for 60ml**

'My feet were very dry and cracked and this cream worked extremely well. I have tried lots of other products which have never worked - this one did. I would definitely buy this again.' **10/10**

**TESTED: Naitiques Avocado Foot Crème, £14.45 for 113.4g**

'This cream was easily absorbed into my feet and had a very pleasant smell. It softened most of the skin but didn't make much difference to the very hard-skinned areas. I wouldn't buy this again.' **6/10**
